Coronary artery anomalies are abnormalities in the origin, course or distribution of the coronary arterial circulation There are various definitions of coronary anomalies The most comprehensive of them is that proposed by Angelini [1] Normal is any morphological feature observed in more than 1% of an unselected population and anomaly is a morphological feature seen in less than 1% of that

### **Implications of Anomalous Left Coronary Artery Origin**

The comprehensive classification of the categories is based on the origination and course, intrinsic anatomy, termination Among all the known types of coronary anomalies, the left main coronary artery arising from the right coronary sinus with an interarterial course is associated with higher morbidity and mortality because of the highly associated risks of exertional angina, syncope
